Eran:	be-tach! at ho-le-chet le-me-si-ba?	Of course! Are you going to a party?	ערן: בטח! את הולכת למסיבה?
Liat:	ka-mu-van! a-ni mit-cha-pe-set le-Esther ha-mal-ka!	Or course! I'm masquerading as Queen Esther!	ליאת: כמובן! אני מתחפשת לאסתר המלכה!
Eran:	a-ni mit-cha-pes le-Mor-de-chay ha-ye-hu-di. yesh lach tach-po-set ya-fa?	I'm masquerading as Mordecai. Do you have a nice costume?	ערן: אני מתחפש למרדכי היהודי! יש לך תחפושת יפה?
Liat:	ha-chi ya-fa! a-ni ha-mal-ka ha-chi ya-fa ba-me-si-ba!	The most beautiful! I'm the prettiest queen at the party!	ליאת: הכי יפה! אני המלכה הכי יפה במסיבה!
Eran:	Pu-rim ze chag mak-sim	Purim is a wonderful holiday!	ערן: פורים זה חג מקסים
Liat:	Ken, ku-lam mit-chap-sim ve-hol-chim le-me-si-bot!	Yes, Everyone is masquerading and going to parties!	ליאת: כן, כולם מתחפשים והולכים למסיבות!
Eran:	Ve-zzo-cha-kim ve-rok-dim!	And laughing and dancing	ערן: וצוחקים ורוקדים!
Liat:	cha-val she-yesh rak pa-am be-sha-na	It's a shame it's only once a year!	ליאת: חבל שיש רק פעם בשנה!
Eran:	lo kol yom Pu-rim!	Not every day is Purim!	ערן: לא כל יום פורים!

Liat:	Ken, ku-lam mit-chap-sim ve-hol-chim le-me-si-bot!	Yes, Everyone is masquerading and going to parties!	לִיאֵת: כֵּן, כּוֹלָם מִתְחַפְּשִׁים וְהוֹלְכִים לְמִסִּיבוֹת!
Eran:	Ve-zzo-cha-kim ve-rok-dim!	And laughing and dancing	עֵרָן: וְצוֹחֲקִים וְרוֹקְדִים!
Liat:	cha-val she-yesh rak pa-am be-sha-na	It's a shame it's only once a year!	לִיאֵת: חָבֵל שִׁישׁ רַק פַּעַם בְּשָׁנָה!
Eran:	lo kol yom Pu-rim!	Not every day is Purim!	עֵרָן: לֹא כָל יוֹם פּוּרִים!

Dayal/dayelet	Steward/ stewardess
Rakdan/rakdanit	Dancer Rakdan for a male, rakdanit for a female
Arnav/arnevet	Rabbit Arnav for a male, arnevet for a female
